

Agency 36 - State Racing Commission

Statutory Authority:

Nebraska Revised Statutes Chapter 2, Sections 1201 through 1247. The Nebraska Racing Commission has adopted and filed Administrative Rules Title 294 with the Reviser of Regulations as authorized by Statute.

Vision Statement:

Prevent and eliminate corrupt practices in horse racing and breeding, maintain a high level of integrity and honesty in the horse racing industry, promote horse racing and breeding in the state, and receive and disperse funds pursuant to statutory requirements.

Mission Statement:

The Racing Commission carries out its mission as authorized by State Statute under a single agency program titled Enforcement of Standards. The Racing Commission is cash funded entirely by fees collected from the Racing Industry. In addition to its operations funding, the Racing Commission collects payments from all racetracks pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes 2-1208.04 and dispenses the funds collected to recipient tracks defined by statute. The purpose of this pass through funding is to promote horse racing and breeding supplementing purses at smaller tracks.

Goals:

The staffing and resources needed by the Racing Commission to meet its regulatory responsibility are largely determined by the number of race tracks and the number of days on which live racing is conducted, and to a lesser extent by the number of approved simulcast facilities.

Consistent with statutory requirements that specify the number of live racing days required as a condition for interstate simulcasting, Nebraska tracks have applied for and been granted a minimum of 103 days of live racing. In calendar year 2004 Nebraska tracks are approved to conduct 105 days. Nebraska current funding and continuation budget request have been developed based on that level of live racing.
