

Agency 62 - Board Of Examiners Land Surveyors

Statutory Authority:

Secs. 81-8,108 to 81-8,127, Neb.Rev.Stat. (Reissue 1981) provides the authority and defines the duties of the Board of Examiners for Land Surveyors. A complete set of Rules and Regulations are on file with the Revisor of Regulations. These Rules and Regulations were last revised August 30, 1999 under Title 234.

Vision Statement:

The Board of Examiners for Land Surveyors seeks to continue to safeguard life, health and property of the people of the State of Nebraska by assuring, through education, training, evaluation and examination, that all those practicing or offering to practice land surveying in this state are qualified to do so.

Mission Statement:

The mission of the State Board of Examiners for Land Surveyors is to enforce and administer the laws relating to regulation of land surveying through licensing in Nebraska and to ensure the quality of land surveying in Nebraska for the protection of the public.

Goals:

The protection of the citizens of the State of Nebraska is the long range goal of the Board of Examiners for Land Surveyors. Protection will be provided through examination for registration and the regulation and continuing education of all Professional Land Surveyors registered in Nebraska. The primary focus of regulation and education are ethical practice, professional competency, and technical proficiency.

- 4 land surveyor applicants were issued registrations
- 6 land surveyor registrations were issued by reciprocity
- 13 land surveyor registrations were delinquent, reclassified or canceled.

As of July 1, 2005 there were 277 land surveyor registrations in force.

FY 05-06

- 19 surveyor-in-training applicants were examined
- 9 surveyor-in-training applicants were issued certificates
- 4 land surveyor applicants were examined
- 3 land surveyor applicants were issued registrations
- 4 land surveyor registrations were issued by reciprocity
- 1 land surveyor registration was reinstated

As of July 1, 2006 there were 285 land surveyor registrations in force.
