

# Agency 36 - State Racing Commission

## Statutory Authority:

Nebraska Revised Statutes Chapter 2, Section 1201 through 1246. The Nebraska State Racing Commission has adopted and filed Administrative Rules Title 294 with the Revisor of Regulations as authorized by statute.

## Vision Statement:

The vision of the commission is to prevent and eliminate corrupt practices and fraudulent behavior, and to maintain a high level of integrity and honesty in the horse racing industry in Nebraska.

## Mission Statement:

MISSION: The commission carries out functions authorized by statute under the operations program titled ENFORCEMENT OF STANDARDS. The commission enforces statutory requirements and promulgates and enforces regulations.

PRINCIPLES: Protect, preserve, and promote agriculture and horse racing through effective and efficient effort to prevent and eliminate corrupt practices; insure fairness in decisions affecting licensees and patrons; insure due process in administrative proceedings; be attentive to the public and licensees and provide information concerning the industry and commission operations.

## Goals:

The goal of the Racing Commission is to carry out the Enforcement of Standards program at an expenditure level that is reasonable in relation to the amount of live horse racing, number of licenses issued, and amount of wagering on horse races.

Goals for calendar years 1999 (FY00) and 2000 (FY01) are:

1. program expenses/live racing days - \$5243 per day,
2. program expenses/licenses issued - \$270 per license issued,
3. program expenses/amount wagered - 1/2 cent per dollar wagered.
