SUBJECT: ARRA Section 1512 Compliance Memo  
FederalReporting.gov Reports Linkage Function during Continuous QA Period

Federal Agencies are asked in the attached April 6<sup>th</sup> White House memorandum to intensify efforts to improve reporting compliance by Recovery Act prime recipients. By May 5<sup>th</sup>, federal agencies must report the identities of prime recipients who have not filed Section 1512 reports and outline enforcement actions.

April 10<sup>th</sup> Section 1512 data is now published on Recovery.gov. The federal agencies will check to see that the April 10<sup>th</sup> report link to the January 10<sup>th</sup> report for an award is correct. If the federal agency detects a problem with report linkage, you will be contacted by your federal agency and comments will appear in "My Work Queue" in FederalReporting.gov. The training document for the reports linkage function is attached. ("Agency User" refers to the federal agency.) If contacted, you will need to follow the training guide and perform the necessary actions to resolve the linkage issue.

Prior quarter links are visible. If you view a problem with prior quarter links, contact your federal agency to request a report link correction.

Also displayed on FederalReporting.gov is the continuous quality assurance schedule for the April 10<sup>th</sup> Section 1512 reports. Section 1512 reports that you re-submit during the continuous QA period will be published on Recovery.gov May 19<sup>th</sup>, June 2<sup>nd</sup> and June 16<sup>th</sup>. Please upload any revised Section 1512 reports to StateReporting.Nebraska.gov also.

Please utilize the continuous QA period to become familiar with the new reports linkage function and conduct a quality assurance review of Section 1512 reports.
