SUBJECT: End of ARRA Section 1512 Quarterly Reporting

The January 17, 2014 enactment of the Federal Government's Fiscal Year 2014 [Omnibus Spending Bill](#) (Sec. 627) brings to an end to American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Section 1512 reporting as of February 1, 2014.

The current reporting cycle for the 4th quarter of 2013 continues as scheduled with the January 30th publication of the reported data on [Recovery.gov](#) and the continuous quality assurance period ending in late March 2014. Please continue to follow the instructions and timeline as outlined in the December 2013 Section 1512 Reporting memo sent by the Administrative Services State Budget Division.

The Recovery Board is preparing a process for making final corrections where needed. From then on, the data will remain static in [Recovery.gov](#) and [StateReporting.Nebraska.gov](#).

We will share additional information with you when it becomes available from the Recovery Board. Federal agencies may also be communicating specific instructions to you regarding your currently active ARRA grants. For ARRA grants that are still active, continue to follow the terms of the grant agreement and instructions from your federal agency. Please close out completed ARRA grants in the State of Nebraska Enterprise One system.
