Subject: American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Section 1512 Reporting Requirements

This past week I participated in a telephone call with Vice President Biden and representatives from the other state governments regarding the reporting requirements for primary recipients of federal funds under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Vice President Biden specifically asked State officials to remind non-state government organizations about the upcoming October 10, 2009, deadline for primary recipients of ARRA monies to submit reports to www.FederalReporting.gov as required by Section 1512 of ARRA. This brief memorandum is sent as that reminder.

This reminder is intended for organizations that are receiving ARRA grant awards directly from the federal government and consequently required to file a report as a primary recipient pursuant to Section 1512 of ARRA.

If your organization is a sub-recipient of ARRA monies from a Nebraska state government agency, that state agency is responsible, as the direct primary recipient, for submitting the reports required by Section 1512 of ARRA. That state agency will contact you for any needed information for that purpose.

I have attached additional reference material to aid in your organization's efforts to understand and perform responsibilities related to the requirements of Section 1512 of the ARRA.
