

## REFERENCE INFORMATION REGARDING AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) SECTION 1512 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Key responsibilities for primary recipients of ARRA monies identified by the White House Office of Management and Budget (OMB) include:

- The prime recipient is responsible for all reporting both from the prime recipient and the sub-recipient for their specific grant award.
- The prime recipient must complete the necessary planning and communication to assure the timely and accurate sharing and reporting of the required information.
- The prime recipient must have a written data collection plan and data quality review plan containing the necessary internal controls to assure the timely and accurate reporting of information.
